The safety of our guests and staff is top priority. We are taking protective measures to help prevent and limit the spread of COVID 19. All public space and back-of-house hand-contact surfaces will be sanitized multiple times per shift with anti-viral disinfectant, including (but not limited to):

- Door handles & door plates
- Stair banisters and handrails
- Reception desk, pens, computers & keyboards
- Light switches & elevator button
- Card keys at check-in & check-out
- All kitchen equipment
- Towel dispensers
- Public & private restrooms

Hand sanitizing stations will be placed in key guest/staff entrances & locations. All food will be Grab n’ Go. We will also have social distance markers, safety posters & plexi-glass in place at guest transaction areas:



- Front Desk
- Bookstore/Café
- Castle Dining Room
- Castle Foyer
- Staff work-stations & offices



Housekeeping services will be provided by an opt-in basis. Guest rooms will only be serviced after check-out or upon request. All rooms will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected:

- Door handles & door plates
- Desk, table, chairs, lamp
- Dresser drawer handles
- Light switches, thermostats & A/C unit
- Telephone & keypad
- Alarm clock
- Drapery pull handles & hangers
- Faucet, shower, toilet handles



All staff will begin each work day with a health screening. Staff who are unwell or do not pass the health screening will be asked to stay home. In accordance with government regulations, all guests and staff over 10 years in age are required to wear masks while indoors, except when in your guest room with the door closed.
